





SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS EUROPEAN OPEN ROAD RACING CHAMPIONSHIP 20, 21 and 22 of OCTOBER 2006

1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Club Motor Cartagena from Cartagena, on behalf of RFME, will organise the EUROPEAN OPEN ROAD RACING CHAMPIONSHIP, at the Circuit of Cartagena. This event will be held on 20, 21 and 22 of October 2006.

It will count towards the 2006 European Open Road Race Championship, in the classes of 125 cc, 250 cc and Supersport.

Additional classes are: the Stocksport 600, the Women's Cup and the Classic Grand Prix for the UEM Cup.

3. CIRCUIT

The length of the Circuit is 3,506 km. All races will be run clockwise. The Circuit is located in Ctra. La Aljorra KM 2,6 Cartagena. The start and finish lines are located on two different places. The start line is the white-line and the finish line is the yellow line with a distance between of approx. 60 mtr. A drawing of the Circuit is enclosed.

This event will be held in accordance with the UEM Sporting Code, the UEM Road Racing Rules, these Supplementary Regulations and further issues of official announcements.

6. CATEGORIES AND CLASSES

- Solo: 125 cc, 250 cc, and SUPERSPORT for the Euro Champ.

- Solo: STOCKSPORT 600, Women's Cup (Stsp 600 and 1000) and the Classic

Grand Prix (250 cc and 350 cc) for the UEM Cup

7. NUMBER OF RIDERS ALLOWED

The maximum number of riders allowed will be as follows:

8. ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEE

Applications must be approved by the rider's FMN and must reach the organiser **not later than 10 October 2006.**

The entry fee is fixed at € 150,-- (non-reimbursable) per rider and per class. If the organiser receives the entry after closing date of entries, the entry fee will be € 200,-- per rider and per class.

Entries must be sent in writing on the official UEM Entry Form, together with the entry fee of each class, up to 10 days before the event starts, to:

The organiser will select the applications and advice riders within 72 hours after the closing date of entries whether their applications have been accepted or rejected. Riders must be in possession of a valid license of the UEM or another CONU, which is delivered by the rider's FMN.

Riders holders of a valid and permanent Grand Prix FIM License, World SBK, SS and/or Endurance Championship Licence cannot participate.

9. REGISTRATION and TECHNICAL SCRUTINEERING

No rider or machine is permitted onto the track unless he/it has passed the technical inspections which will be held according to the following schedule:

10. PRACTISING

It is strictly forbidden to ride racing motorcycles from participants on circuit outside the Official practice periods.

Transponders will be used. The deposit for one transponder is € 300,-- .

a. Supplementary practices

On Thursday afternoon 19 and Friday morning 20 October there will be Supplementary Free practices.

All participants of this event with a valid UEM licence may participate in these practices. The costs are \in 50,-- per rider per practice of minimum 30 minutes.

b. Official Practices

The minimum number of laps (during official practices) to be qualified is 5.

To qualify for a EC-race, a rider must achieve at least a time equal to 110% of the fastest lap from the rider of his class.

For the Cup's it is: 120 %. Exception of this rule for the Int. Classic Grand Prix.

12. PRIZES

The prizes shall be paid according to the UEM Road Racing Rule RR 03.6.1







Payment of prizes will be done one hour after the official results of the races at the secretariat office near the Control tower.

13. PRIZE GIVING

The prize-giving ceremony will be held after the end of all races at the podium in the Paddock. Hereafter the **European Champions Ceremony** will take place. Everybody is kindly invited to join these ceremonies.

14. PROTESTS

All protests must be made in accordance with the requirements of the UEM Disciplinary and Arbitration Code and be accompanied by a fee of \in 130,-- .

15. FUEL

There will be no fuel supplied on the paddock.

16. INSURANCE

By endorsing the application form for entry, the FMN of the rider certifies that the rider is insured in accordance with the UEM requirements.

In conformity with article 110.1 of the Sporting Code, third party insurance in respect of riders covering accidents occurring during the event including practices, will be the responsibility of the organiser.

The organiser disclaims all responsibility for damage to a motorcycle, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other cases.

17. RENUNCIATION OF ANY RECOURSE AGAINST SPORTING AUTHORITIES

Apart from the requirements of the UEM Sporting Code, riders by participating, renounce all rights of appeal against the organiser, his representatives or agents by arbitration or before a tribunal or any other manner not foreseen by the UEM Sporting Code for any damages for which they could be liable, in consequence of all acts or omissions on the part of the organiser, his officials, representatives or agents in the application of these Regulations or contributed to or arising out of their actions.
